

LEARN TO CROCHET

In this class you will learn the chain and single crochet stitches, using them to make a pair of fingerless gloves (aka - hand warmers, gauntlets, etc). Even if you have never picked up a crochet hook before, you will be able to learn these simple stitches and make a stylish pair of hand warmers. There will be a handout with pattern, stitch guide, source of tutorials, etc.

SUPPLY LIST

1. **1** ball Red Heart Super Saver yarn in the colour of your choice (available at Wal-Mart) or any other number 4 gauge yarn (e.g. - worsted, Aran) also called medium gauge. I would suggest a solid colour as it will be easier to see your stitches.
2. **1** metal crochet hook – size 5.50mm to 6.50mm (US sizes I-9 to K-10 1/2) – it is suggested that you use a metal hook as it slips through the stitches much easier than a plastic or bamboo hook. When using acrylic yarns (as the Super Saver yarn is) a plastic hook will seem kind of sticky when crocheting.
3. **1** large eyed yarn needle - the kind with a blunt pointy end – can be plastic or metal but, needs to have a good sized eye to accommodate the yarn.
4. It may also be a good idea to bring a pair of scissors and a note pad and pencil.
